



- + Follow the teal path for The Bone and Joint Center.
- + Follow the red path for the Emergency Department

If you would like personal assistance, there are Information Desks in the first floor lobbies of the Main Hospital, Emergency Department, and The Bone and Joint Center. If at any time you need help during your visit, go to an Information Desk or ask anyone wearing a hospital identification badge. We'll be happy to walk you to your destination.

OhioHealth Grant Medical Center is located at 111 S Grant Ave, at the corner of S Grant Ave and E State St.


FROM THE NORTH: Take I-71 South to the US-40/Broad St exit. Turn right onto E Broad St. Take a left onto S Grant Ave (left turn time restricted).

FROM THE SOUTH: Take I-71 North to I-70 E to Fourth St. Turn left on S Fourth St. Turn right onto E Town St, then left onto S Grant Ave.


FROM THE EAST: Take I-70 West to E Mound St. Take exit 101B toward Hospital/Downtown. Continue onto E Mound St, then turn right onto S Grant Ave.

FROM THE WEST: Take I-70 East to I-670 East. Take exit 4A-4B-4C to merge onto US 23 South/N Third St. Continue on N Third St, then turn left onto E Broad St and then right on S Grant Ave.






FIRST FLOOR

PARKING

OhioHealth Grant Medical Center offers free garage and valet parking to patients and visitors. If you park in a garage, you must take your parking ticket inside with you to have your parking validated. Parking validation is available at information desks throughout the hospital; look for signage or ask anyone wearing an OhioHealth ID badge for assistance.

Valet parking is available during set hours, but retrievals are available by calling (614) 788-5858. Call (614) 566-9368 for current hours.

- + Grant Cancer Center: Monday-Friday, 7:30 AM 4 PM
- + Wilkins Building: Monday- Friday, 7:30 AM 4 PM
